Wheels to Work is a moped leasing scheme aimed at helping young people and the unemployed to get over the initial problem of getting to work, training or education.

This project aims to offer a transport solution where no suitable transport alternatives exist.

What we provide to you:

- Moped on loan for up to 6 months
- Tax, Insurance (no personal accident insurance.)
- Servicing
- Roadside Recovery Service
- Compulsory Basic Training course
- Helmet, waterproofs, gloves and vest.

What we ask of you in return:

- Pay your contributions on time
- Look after your bike, keep it clean and report any problems
- Keep in regular contact with Liam
- Bring your bike in for it's service yourself.
- Only ever use the W2W approved oils
- Ride and use the bike responsibly at all times

What does it cost?

There are 2 categories of payment as follows:

Category	Rate per Week	Monthly Payment
Standard Rate	£10	£43
Training/Education Rate	£8	£35

Payments are made by setting up a standing order with your bank, this means that your bank will automatically take the money out of your account and send it to us each month.

You pay for your petrol and oil, and you are responsible for the

cost of any damage incurred / insurance excess up to £250 per incident. We ask for a £50 bond which will be returned to you at the end of your time on the scheme, provided the moped is undamaged, you have made all your payments and completed a questionnaire about the scheme. Interest will not be paid on this money.

Am I eligible?

Our eligibility criteria for the scheme are : -

- The applicant must live in Nottinghamshire.
- Have the offer of a job, training course or place in education.
- No suitable alternative means of transport to access these opportunities.
- Must live in, or be trying to access a rural area.

We are not able to provide a moped where public or private transport is available, unless it is a particularly unreasonable journey to make this way. If you are not sure if this means you can apply please phone Liam on 01623 727620 and he will be able to advise you.

How do I apply?

If you are under 18 and thinking of applying you will need to discuss this with your parents or guardian as we will need their consent. Complete the enclosed application form, and send it to Liam Russell at the address on the back cover.

What happens next?

You will be contacted by Liam, and if it looks like you might fulfil the criteria you will be invited to attend an initial interview which takes place in a public area such as a Job Centre, library, or Connexions close to your home. Liam will also need to make contact with your manager at work or tutor at college before you can be offered a place on the Wheels to Work Scheme. A decision is generally made a few days later.
